

## **PASSAGE PLANNING.**

### **Harbour Passage plans**

The attention of Owners, Masters and Operators of all vessels is drawn to the requirement for passage planning.

**The Fowey Harbour Commissioners operate a passage planning system for all port movements. This is designed to link into the ships passage plan.**

For passage planning it is essential to have sufficient and up-to-date information available on board vessels. The harbour Commissioners recommend that the following are carried as a minimum.

The Admiralty charts available for use in the South West approaches along the south coast of Cornwall and approaches to Fowey are as follows:

BA 1267 - Falmouth to Plymouth  
BA 148 - Dodman Point to Looe Bay  
BA 31 - Harbours of the South Coast - Fowey

Before arrival, ships' masters should consult the following Admiralty or similar publications:

When the pilot boards a ship for any movement he will discuss the passage plan with the Master and bridge team and complete and provide a copy of the attached
